Attached is the spreadsheet for the year to date water consumption and the spreadsheet showing comparisons between 2012 and 2011.

You will notice that in October we have had 19 days where we haven't had to water due to rain. This has enabled us to get back on target to meet the budget. The comparison sheet shows that the consumption target, which is approx. 11% less than the 2011 actual, is 2283 m³ above target but, because of cost reductions, we are 15.2% better off than 2011 against the 11% target.

Just a reminder that these are based on the two CREA meters, which do not tally with the Acuamed one, which is the one used for billing. Only the CREA meters can tell us the split between Community and Council land. Fortunately the Acuamed show consumption as less than the CREA meters in 9 out of the 12 weeks we have used both lots of meters. The Acuamed readings show a total 2165 m³ less water consumed than the CREA ones do.
