Opened in 2007, the prestigious Hacienda Riquelme Golf Resort is located in a pretty, rural, location in open countryside, between the village of Sucina and the mountains of Sierra de Carrascoy – an area which has been designated a regional natural park – in the Region of Murcia, in south-east Spain. Yet it is just twenty minutes from the beach and airport.

The resort's buildings keep the charm of the area alive, such as the old manor house, now fully restored as a clubhouse and town centre. The apartments look out over the Nicklaus designed golf course and retain the colonial style of the Riquelme family constructions.

Golf

The golf course was built to championship standards. The 18-hole, par 72, 6,991 yard (6,356 metre) Nicklaus Design course features four sets of tees per hole, presenting challenges to all levels of golfer. It has a range of elevations and uses the natural contours of the land to provide an exceptional golfing experience.

Sports Facilities

There are a wide variety of outdoor sports facilities available. Apart from the golf course and practice facilities, the resort boasts a sports area with two tennis courts, two padel courts, two pétanque lanes and a multi-sports pitch with markings and nets for basketball and soccer. At busy times of the year, the resort tries to organise events here to keep the kids entertained. There is an open-air gym with several pieces of apparatuses. These facilities are free to use for those staying at the resort on a first come first served basis. Just remember to bring your own equipment.



Dining & Bars

The El Casón Restaurant, set in the 19th-century colonial-style Hacienda, serves delicious Mediterranean and International dishes with locally sourced ingredients from the region.

During the summer months, the al-fresco Italian Restaurant opens up in the courtyard serving a variety of authentic Italian cuisine which are also available to takeaway. Also, during the summer, the El Palomar Cocktail Bar, set in a restored dovecote and looking over the golf course, is open for drinks and snacks throughout the evening.

Rules & Regulations

These rules are designed not only for your own safety and enjoyment, but also for other guests and owners who share these wonderful facilities with you.

- i GENERAL.** Be considerate to other guests and owners, some of whom are permanent residents, who share our facilities with you.
- i SECURITY.** The resort is patrolled regularly by our own security staff, day and night. Security can call in the Police for parking offences, bad behaviour, poor driving, high noise levels etc. and they can fine on the resort. If you identify inappropriate behaviour, please phone security on **968 032 039** from your mobile or from your internal phone.
- i SWIMMING POOLS.** Ensure you read and abide by the safety board displayed at each swimming pool. Adults must accompany, and be responsible for, their child's safety at all times. Always close the gate on entering or leaving.

- i NOISE.** Voices and music can travel long distances on the resort, particularly in the evenings. Scraping chairs, closing doors and high heels cause noise throughout the building, so be considerate to other occupants in your building at all times.
- i DOGS.** Spanish law dictates that all dogs should be micro-chipped and registered. Constantly barking dogs are a nuisance, so do not leave your dog unattended for long periods. Dogs must be kept on a lead at all times, anywhere in the resort, and there are several bins to discard mess.
- i CATS.** We have a feral cat population on our resort. They are wild, so should not be fed under any circumstances. Volunteers feed them at designated feeding stations.



Information Office

Open Mon-Tues, Thurs-Fri from 10:00 – 12:00 (excluding bank holidays and festivals) our information office is the glass building near the entrance to the resort on Calle Egeo. It has books, DVDs, and CDs available to buy, exchange or rent. There is a laptop and printer available to use. Printing costs 1€ per page. Our office is a vital resource for owners, tenants, and holidaymakers, providing all the information and leaflets you need. The local volunteers have a wealth of knowledge related to HR, the area, and living in Spain. It acts as a hub for information about local tradespeople.
